**DGFP STOCK STATUS NOTES**  
**(For Contraceptives)**  
**Month: April 2020**

**CONDOM** – Current national stock is 79.39 million pieces and this stock can be used up to January 2021.

- 2019-20: GoB (Rev.) – 175.75 million pcs: DGFP received 69.62 million as of 30<sup>th</sup> April 2020. Rest 106.13 million is scheduled to deliver to DGFP from May 2020 and onward.

**PILL** – Current national stock of Oral Contraceptive Pill is 50.12 million cycles which will go up to December 2020.

- 2019-20: GoB (Rev) – 4 million cycles (3rd generation): Goods received in full quantity on 17<sup>th</sup> February 2020.
- 2019-20: GoB (Rev) – 1 million cycles (POP): Goods received in full quantity on 04/12/2019.
- 2019-20: GoB (RPA) – 50 million cycles (2nd generation): Revised plan. DG – DGFP approved and yet to get approval from MOHFW.
- 2019-20: GoB (RPA) – 10 million cycles (3rd generation) Tender re-evaluated on 21-01-2020. MOHFW approval received and contract signed on 2<sup>nd</sup> week of April.
- 2019-20: GoB (RPA) – 3 million cycles (POP): DGFP received the full quantity on 28<sup>th</sup> April 2020.
- 2019-20: GoB (RPA) – 11 million cycles (3rd generation) Revised plan - IFT published on 28/01/2020. TEC held on 23<sup>rd</sup> March. DG – DGFP approved and sent to MOHFW on 15/04/2020 for approval.

**IUD** – Current national stock is 0.705 million pcs and this stock can be used up to May 2024.

**INJECTABLES** – Current stock of 22.8 million vials and that can be used up to August 2022.

- 2019-20: GoB (Rev) – 4.23 million vials: DGFP received the full quantity on 11<sup>th</sup> November 2019
- 2019-20: GoB (RPA) – 13.25 million vials: DGFP received the full quantity on 28<sup>th</sup> April 2020.

**IMPLANT** – Current stock is 0.416 million sets and this can be used up to April 2021.

- 2019-20: GoB (RPA) - 300,000 sets: IFT re-published on 20/02/2020 separately for single rod and two rod. Due to COVID-19 Pandemic situation tender opening date for 1 stick and for 2 sticks has been re-scheduled on 02/06/2020 & 04/06/2020.
