


DGFP STOCK STATUS REPORT for Contraceptives-31 July 2025





DGFP STOCK STATUS NOTES

(For Contraceptives)
Month: July 2025

- **CONDOM** Current national stock is 17.14 million pieces, and this stock can be used up to November 2025 current average monthly consumption.
 - ➤ FY 2024-25 (Rev.) 15 million pieces of condoms procurement process is completed. EDCL delivered all of the 15 million pieces Condom have been received by the standing board as of July 2025.
- **PILL (Shukhi)** Current national stock of Oral Contraceptive Pill is 15.94 million cycles which will go up to October 2026 based on current average monthly consumption.
 - ➤ FY 2024-25 (Rev.)— 20.4 million cycle Oral Pill (3rd Generation) procurement process is completed. 16.9 million cycle oral pills have been supplied by the contracted suppliers and all have been received by the standing board as of July 2025. Remaining 3.5 million cycle oral pills will be delivered on August 2025 and onward.
- **POP-APON** Current national stock of POP-APON Pill is 0.359 million cycles which will go up to Mid-October 2025 as per current average monthly consumption.
- **IUD** Current national stock is 0.036 million pcs. and this stock can be used up to December 2025.

INJECTABLES – Current stock is 4.52 million vials and that is supposed to be used up to March 2026.

- ➤ FY 2024-25 (Rev.)— 3.6 million vial Injectables procurement process is completed. 3.1 million vial Injectables have been supplied by the contracted supplier and all have been received by the standing board as of June 2025. Remaining 0.5 million vial Injectables will be delivered on July 2025 and onward.
- **IMPLANT** Current stock is 0.090 million sets, and this can be used up to October 2025.
 - ➤ FY 2024-25 (Rev.)— 90,780 set Implant (2 Sticks) procurement process is completed, all of which have been supplied by the contracted supplier and received by the standing board as of July 2025.

Note: Procurement of 100000 sets of Implant (01 Stick) for FY 2024-2025 (Carry Forward) under Revenue budget is in process.
