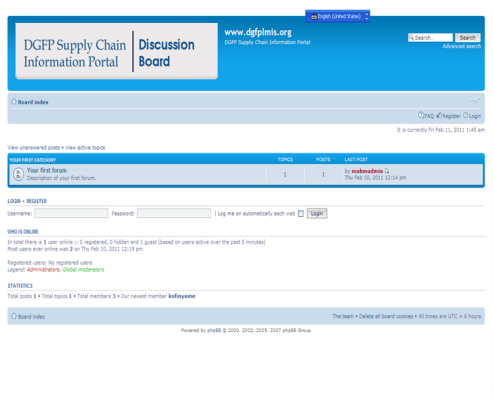


What is the DGFP Supply Chain Discussion Board?

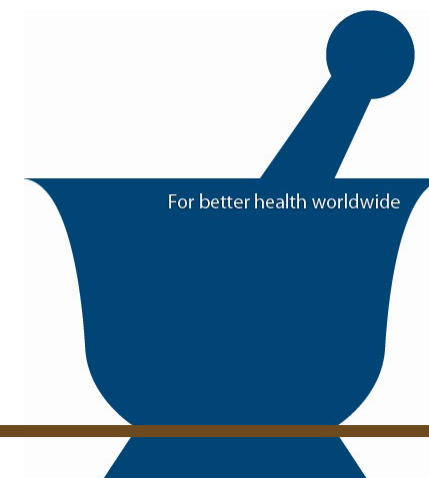

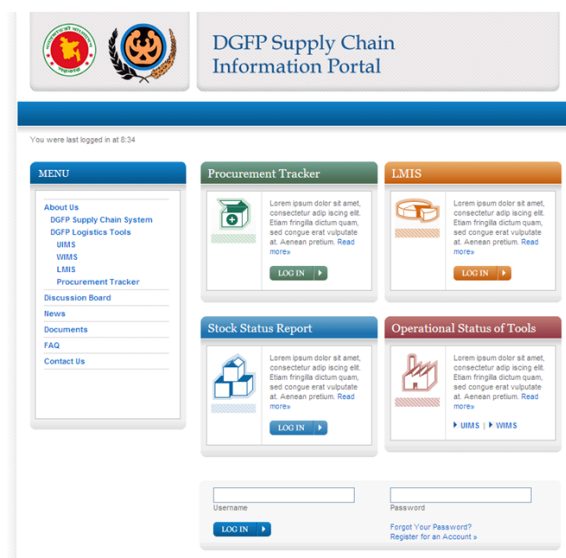
