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About UIMS

The Upazila Inventory Management System (UIMS) is a computer program developed by the USAID|DELIVER PROJECT and updated by Strengthening Pharmaceutical Systems (SPS) Program/Management Sciences for Health (MSH) for the Directorate General of Family Planning (DGFP). It is desktop-based software that enables an upazila to—

- Maintain upazila store inventory
- Automate supply planning
- Automate issue voucher preparation
- Automate monthly LMIS reporting (Form 7B)

Advantages of UIMS

1. Reduces the storekeepers' workload and speeds up the process because they are not required to—
 - Perform calculations, only do data entry
 - Write all the names of the service delivery points each month
 - Prepare issue vouchers
2. Generates Form 7B and the Supply Plan Register automatically
3. Produces various reports
