## About web-based LMIS

The web-based Logistics Management Information System (LMIS) was developed by the USAID | DELIVER PROJECT and updated by the Strengthening Pharmaceutical Systems (SPS) Program for the Directorate General of Family Planning (DGFP).

Features of the web-based LMIS include–

- Central repository for DGFP logistics data
- Stock status data provided for all levels of the supply chain
- Provides consumption data for reproductive health commodities

## Benefits of using the web-based LMIS

- Provides timely information for logistics decision making
- Facilitates decisions making to improve supply chain management
- Donors and stakeholders can access web-based reports
- Upazila and field stock status are available immediately after data entry
- Facilitates supply planning
